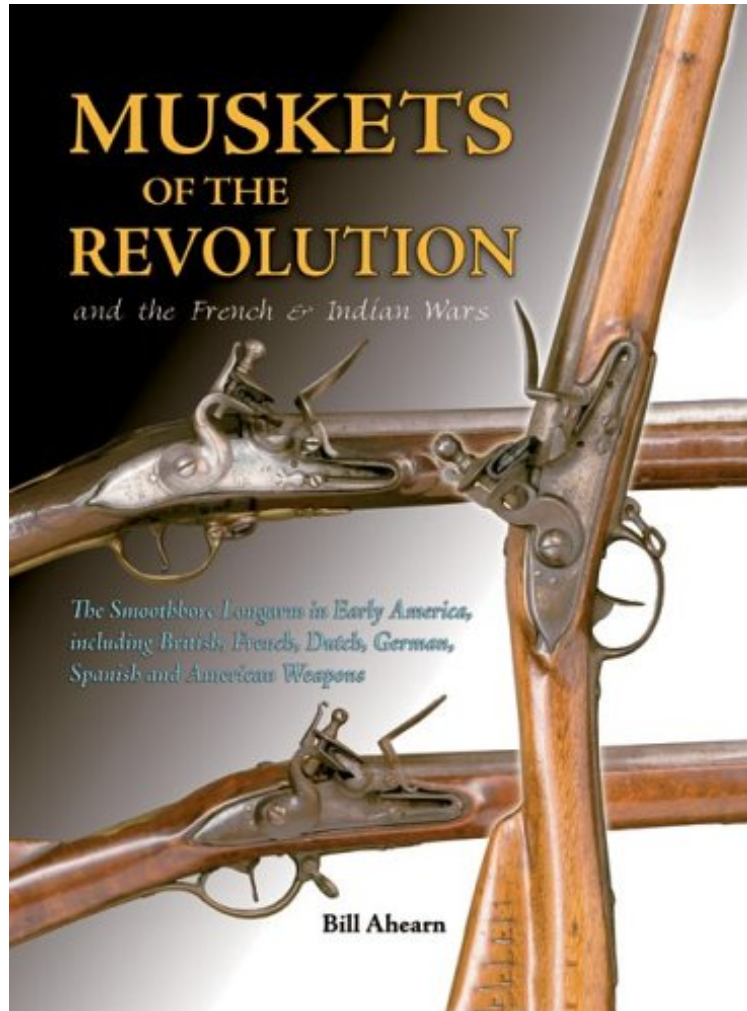

Not a few are similar to the "black cat in coal pile at midnight." Few have the backgrounds removed which with PhotoShop is a major sin. It has been many a year since I have seen photos printed so dark + often w/ corresponding dark gray background. Research is thus negated by poor photos.
