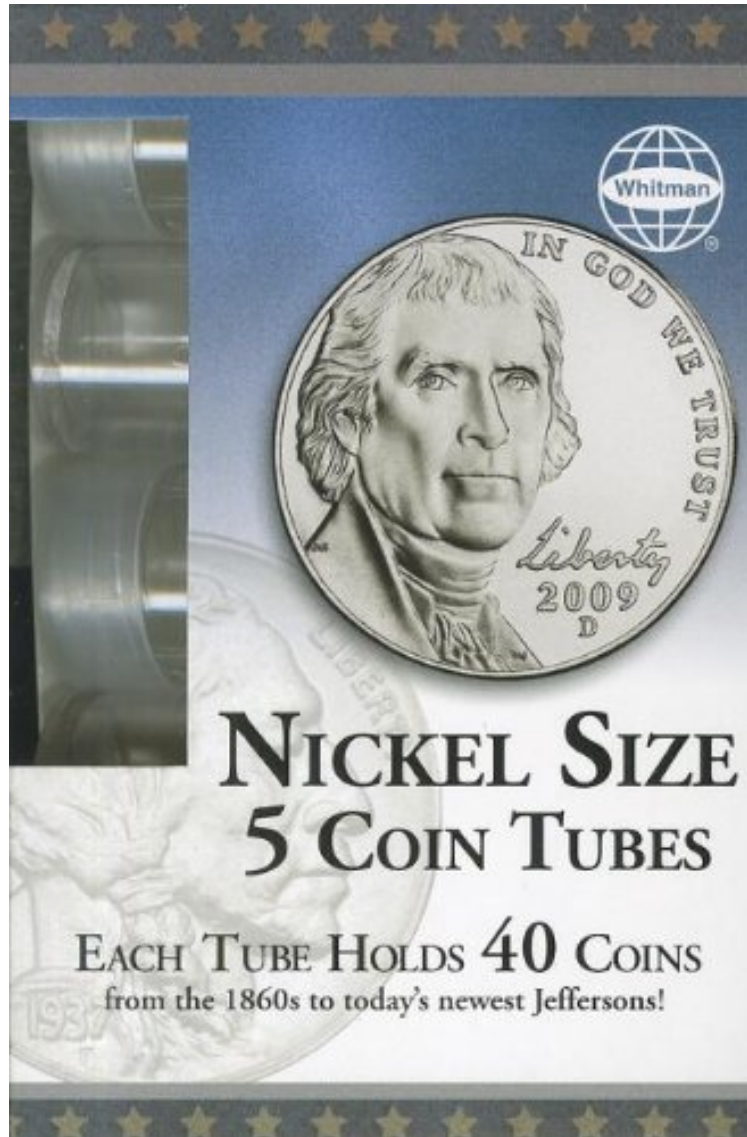

The Whittman penny tubes are fine, but the nickel tubes are too small, and frequently trap the bottom coin in the tube. I've had to break two tubes just to get the coins out. They also often have sharp plastic leftovers from molding that could scratch coins. Don't buy. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful.
