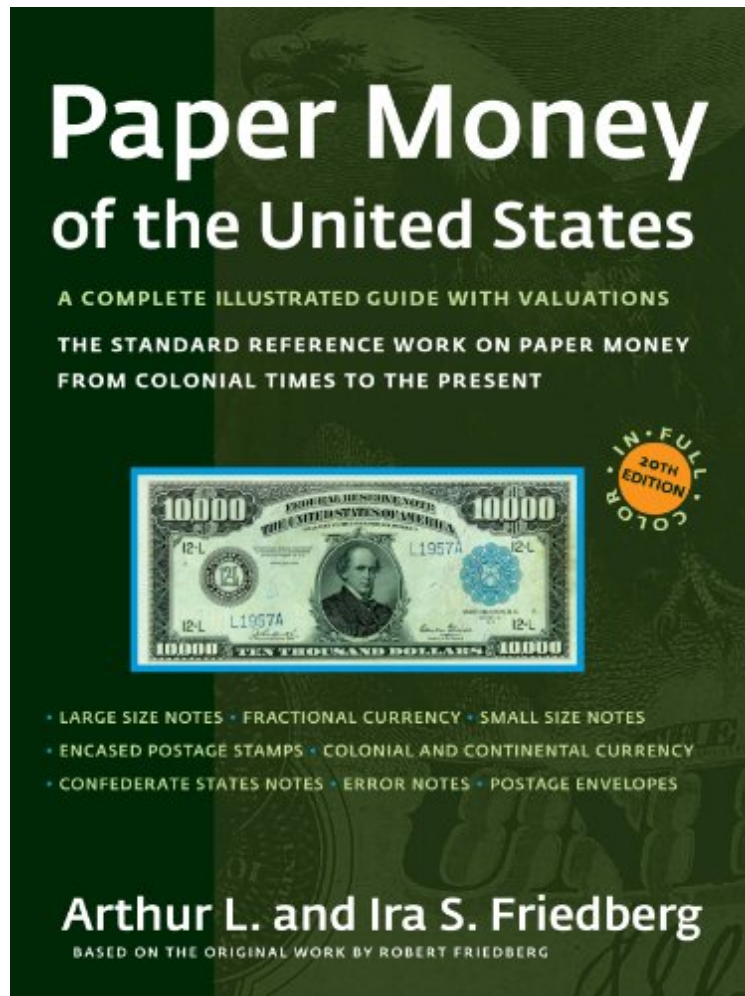

Using the Friedberg catalog numbering system, you can rapidly look for the details on that particular piece of currency. There are many, many beautiful full-color photos for each major type. However, you really need to know the Friedberg number in advance due to the many varieties within each type of currency. The catalog values placed for each note are, to me, just a reference to the scarcity of the note and not the current market value. I've also read that there are some errors in the book regarding values, etc. However, in order to gauge real-world values, eBay and other resources give you much better price

This book is so much more thorough and complete. TERRIBLE WORTHLESS AND UNREADABLE BOOK-----0 stars-----DO NOT BUY THE KINDLE VERSION. I feel terrible giving it 2 stars but I want to make sure everyone sees this. This book has small print on slick expensive paper- and the kindle makes it so tiny you cannot even read it. When you make it larger- its fuzzy and hard to read. Its completely and totally useless in kindle. Dont buy it. When you look at the "sample" on your computer- you have a 13-15" screen and its OK- but you can see its a little fuzzy. When you have a phone or tablet - (or a kindle) you are looking at this on a 3-8" screen (on average) and--if you hold it up and down- portrait- not landscape- the pages are very tiny- so tiny that the resolution of the display cannot make the images (letters) sharp enough to read. Nearly impossible to read- and make out what the pictures and various diagrams/images are. I apologize to the authors and seller for two stars---but I want to make sure no one else buys the kindle version. They wont see my review if I give it 5 stars.
