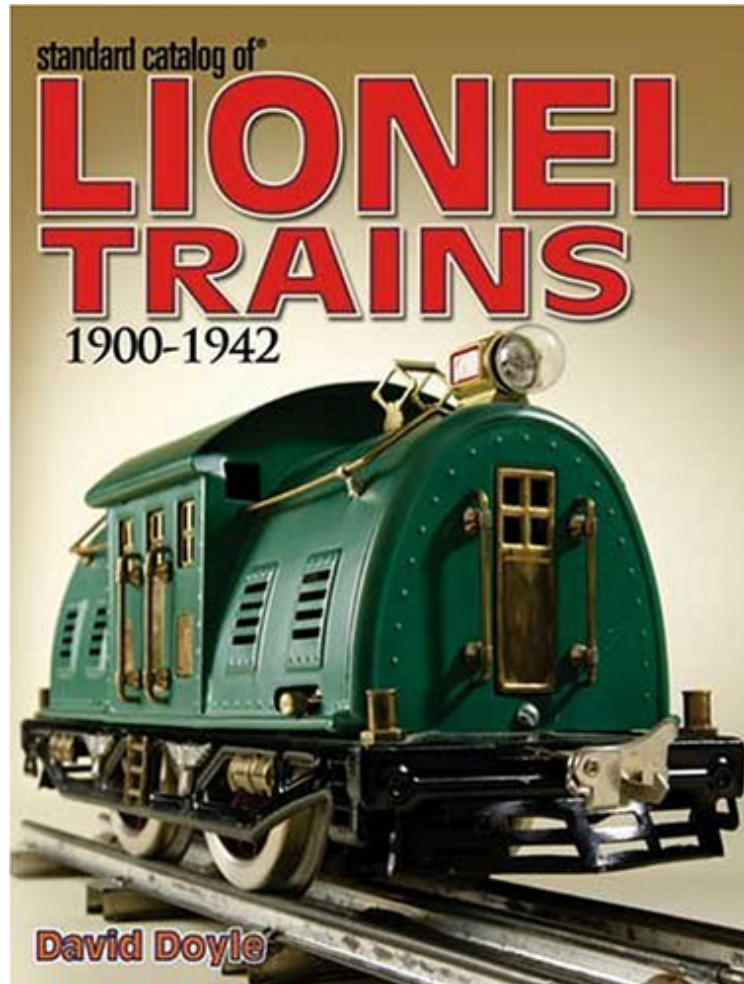

Standard Catalog of Lionel Trains - A valuable resource By 22TWAINSONce in a while there are toy train books that do not bear the "Greenberg" name that are worth buying. This is one of those books. As a Lionel guide, it divides the contents into sections by scale, starting with 2 7/8 inch and finishing with 00 Gauge. There is a final, and valuable section on accessories. Each section isolates a train type, (i.e. steam locomotive, electric locomotive, trolley, etc.) and chronologically lists the varietal types with prices related to condition. There is also an attempt to judge rarity. As with any "price guide," prices change. Being published in 2005 and an second edition in 2008, effects the value of this portion. However, the book more than makes up for this. It is a large volume with also 400 pages. There are color photos on almost every page. One advantage of this guide is the organization. In one place, for each item, it parallels all information and photographs. Then it lists all varieties of that

item in chronological order. As an example, if you are looking for information on a Lionel 112 gondola, this book breaks down that car into 19 types that exist between 1910 and 1926. Newer, and more narrowly focused tomes, such as, "Greenberg's Guide to Lionel Trains, Standard and 2 7/8" Gauges," is certainly more detailed and authoritative and complete. Regarding standard gauge, that is the book that I would buy first. But, it never hurts to have valuable "competitive information and photographs" in your library.
