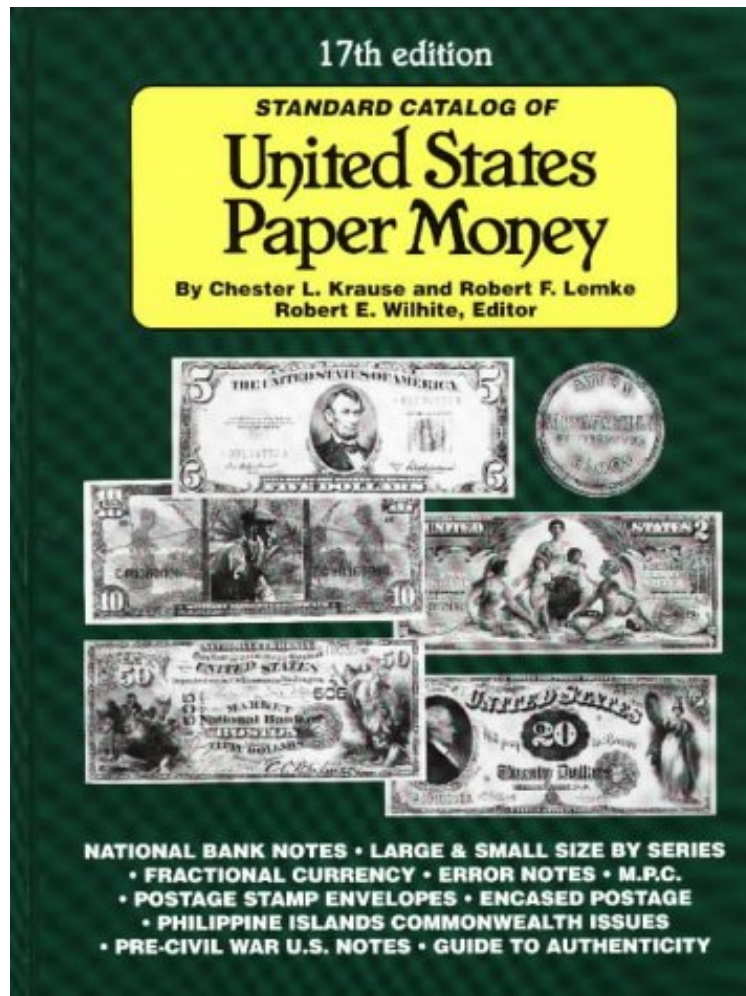

The Catalog contains an excellent reference section on National Bank Notes, receiving much more press than in Friedberg's work. The pricing, while out of date, is actually fairly realistic in today's market, unlike the Black Book or even Friedberg's book. A great plus is that this work is cross referenced by Friedberg Numbers,

which are the standard cataloging numbers used by all dealers and collectors in the hobby. Well worth the investment!

Paper money collectors can have information at their fingertips with this one essential guide. Collectors get information on printed currency from the past 186 years. Small notes, large notes, national bank notes, U.S. Treasury notes, Civil War substitutions, postage stamp envelopes, and error notes are all catalogued. 600 photos.
